

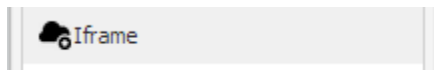
## External iFrame

### Description of Component

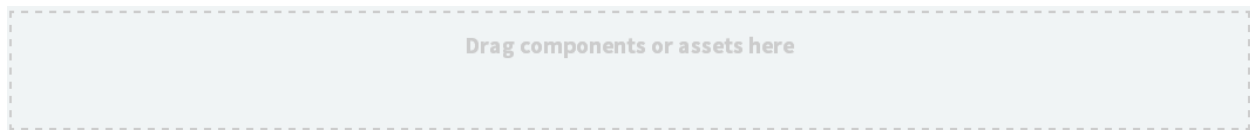
The External iFrame allows a web author to reference an external URL and create a window to display the website in an iFrame.

### How to Use the Component

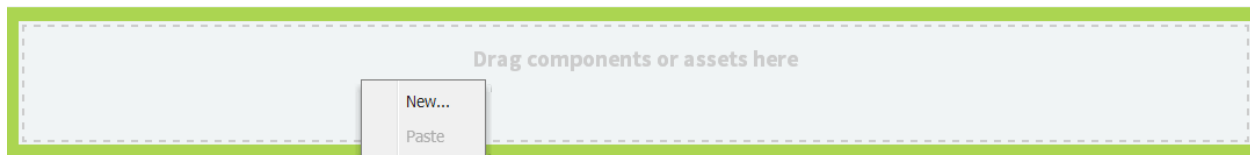
1. You can identify the External iFrame component in the Web Author toolkit as follows:



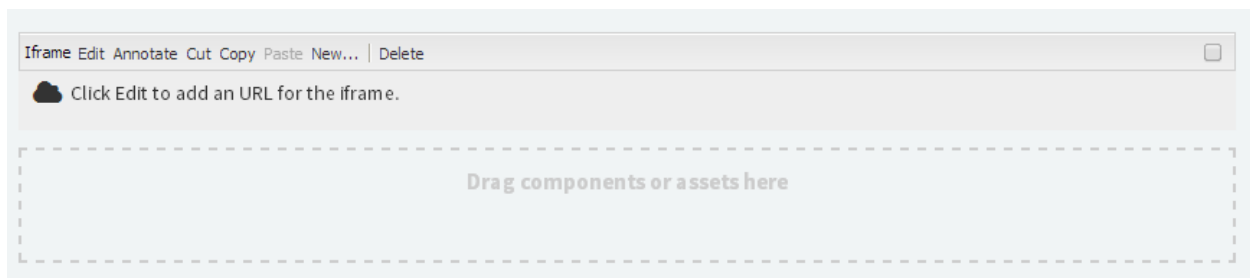
2. Drag the component onto the page in the place where you want the text to display.




3. Or, right click and select New.



4. Select Edit to configure.



5. Select the external link to use. Type the URL in the Target application field in the correct format, similar to: <http://www.example.com>.

6. Leave Pass parameters unchecked.
